### Why focus on Prostate Cancer?

- 1 in 8 men will be diagnosed with Prostate Cancer in their lives.
- It is the most diagnosed cancer in men after skin cancer.
- The average age of diagnosis is 66, but as you get older, your chances go up.
- The good news is that when caught early, the remission/cure rate is 99% after five years.

### Why a support group should be of interest to you:

- Any cancer diagnosis brings with it uncertainty, fear, anger, sadness and more. Though your family and friends may mean well, they may not have faced what you are facing. A support group can fill this need.
- You want to learn more:
  - √ because you may have recently been diagnosed;
  - ✓ because you are in a watch and wait mode due to rising PSA levels;
  - √ to hear about options to manage treatments and their associated side effects;
  - about actual experiences from patients who have faced these challenges, thus
    providing you with local experience where you are most likely to seek treatment;
  - ✓ to understand, as a caregiver, relative or friend, how to better support someone you
    know with Prostate Cancer.
