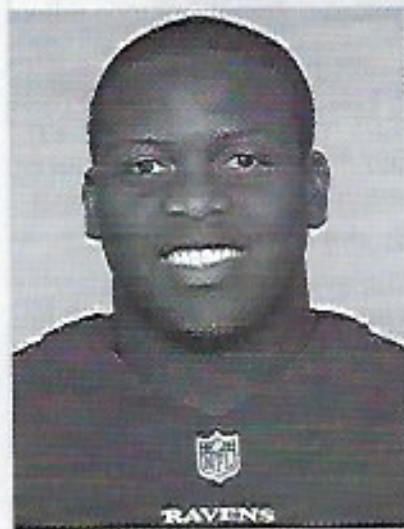


Stonebridge Men's Club
